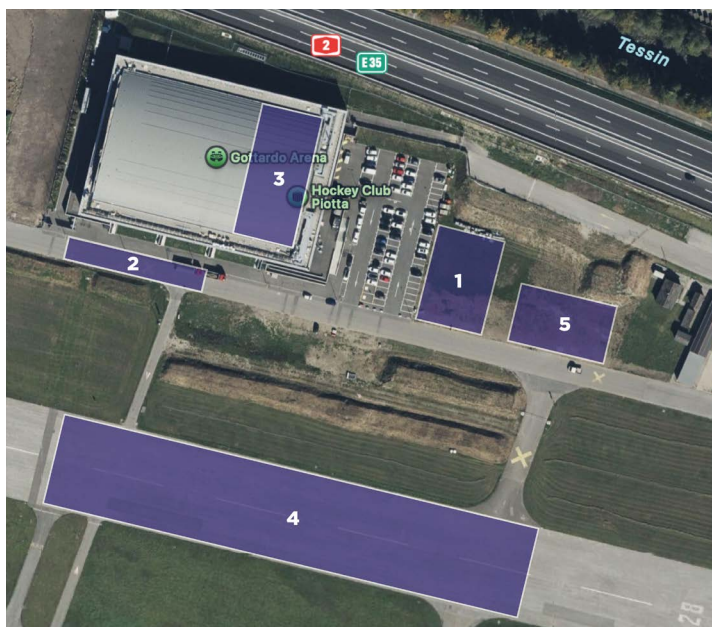

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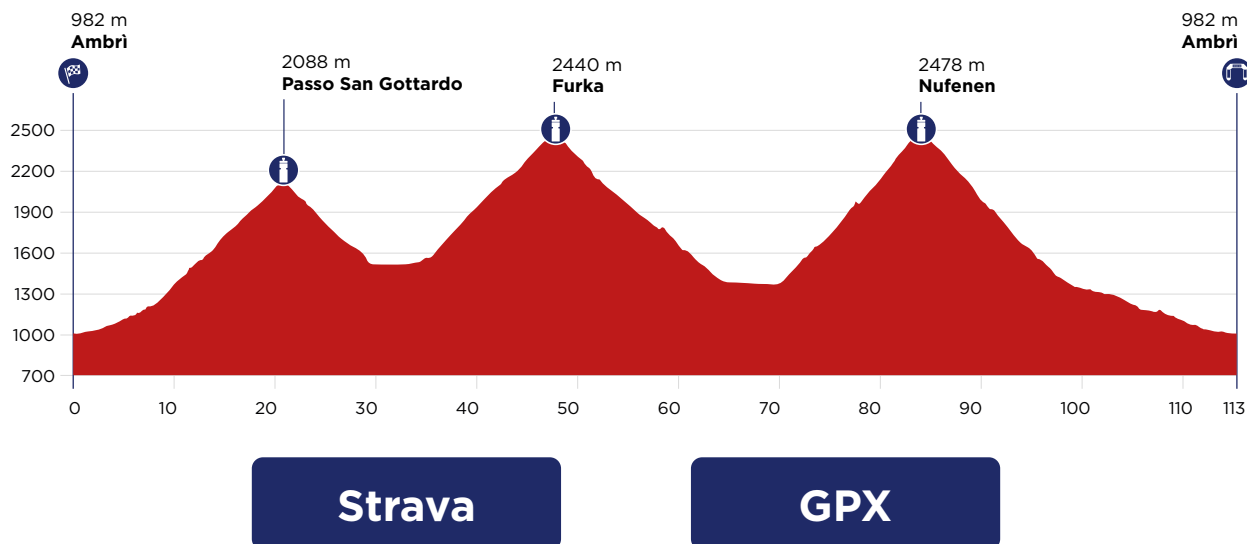
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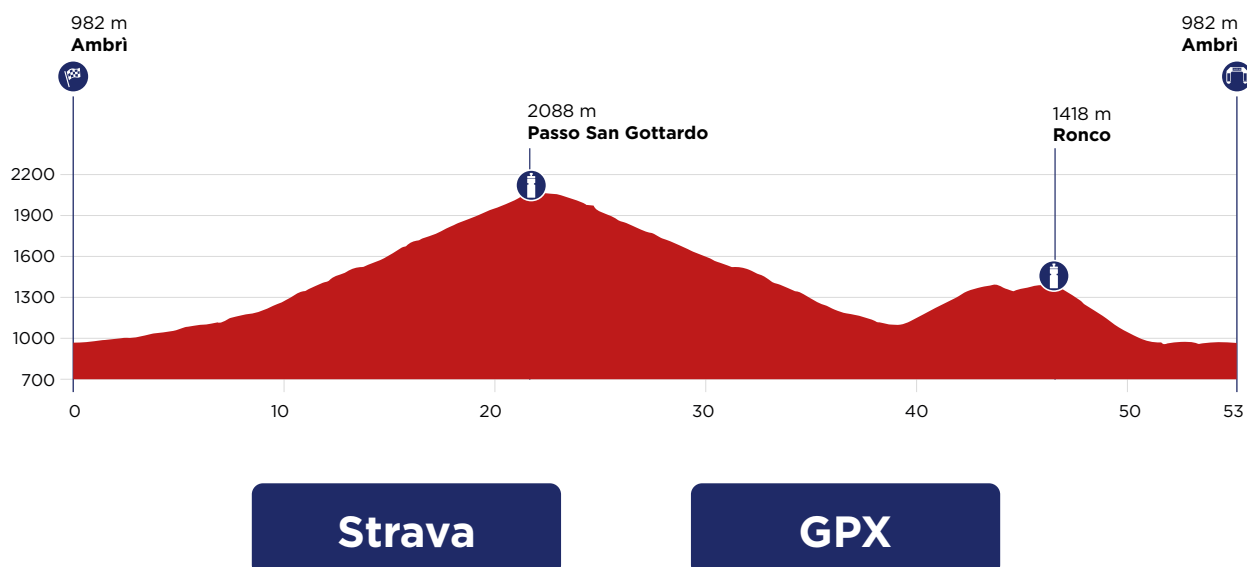
ROUTE - BIG LOOP

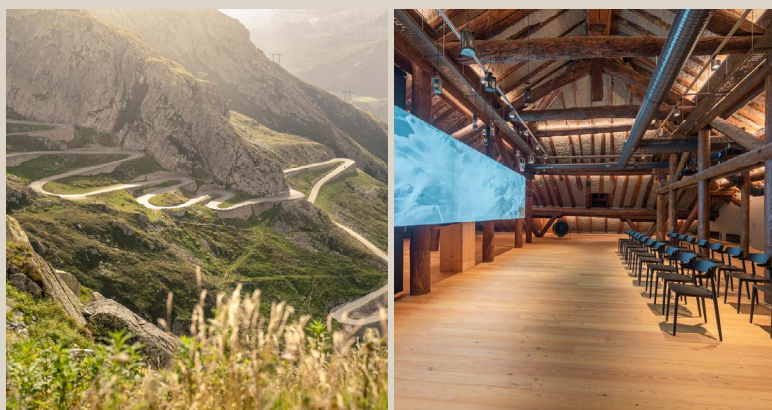


Dal 1° agosto 1986, il Museo Nazionale del San Gottardo accoglie visitatori da ogni parte del mondo.

The visitor experience is enriched by dynamic temporary exhibitions, created in close collaboration with ALPS – Swiss Alpine Museum.



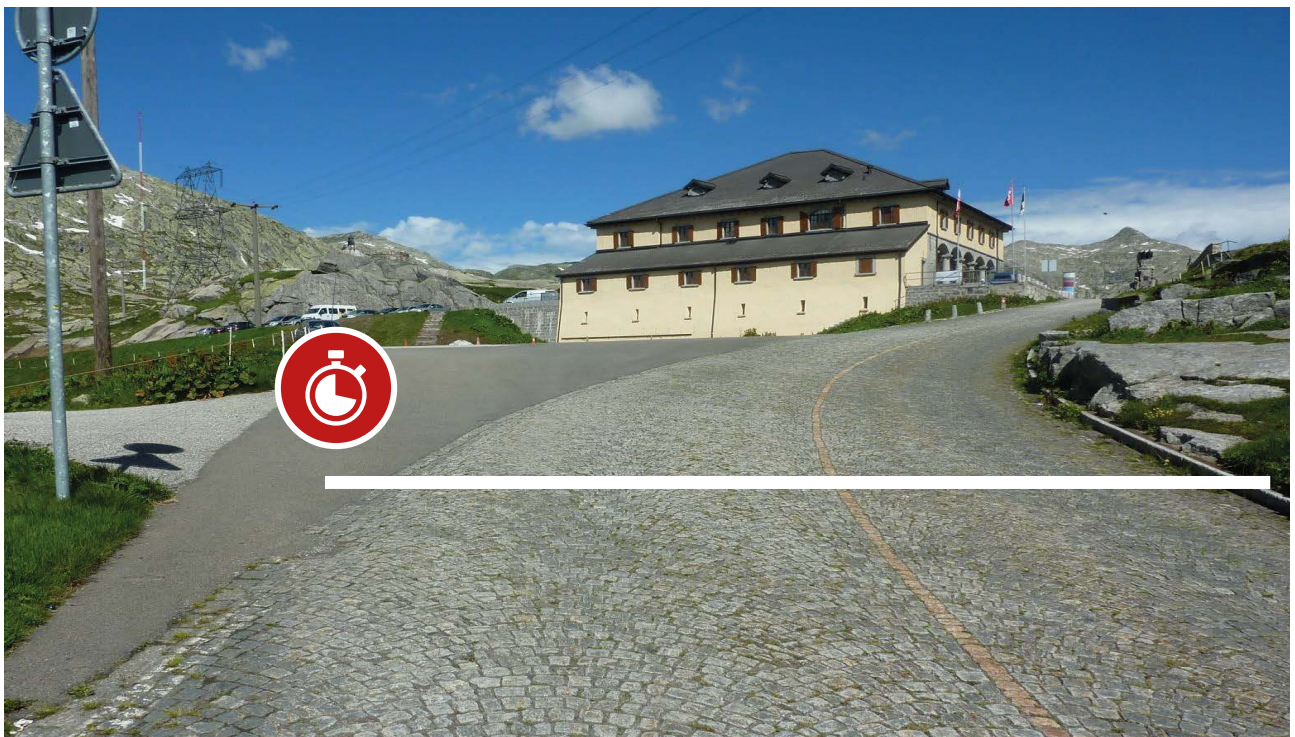

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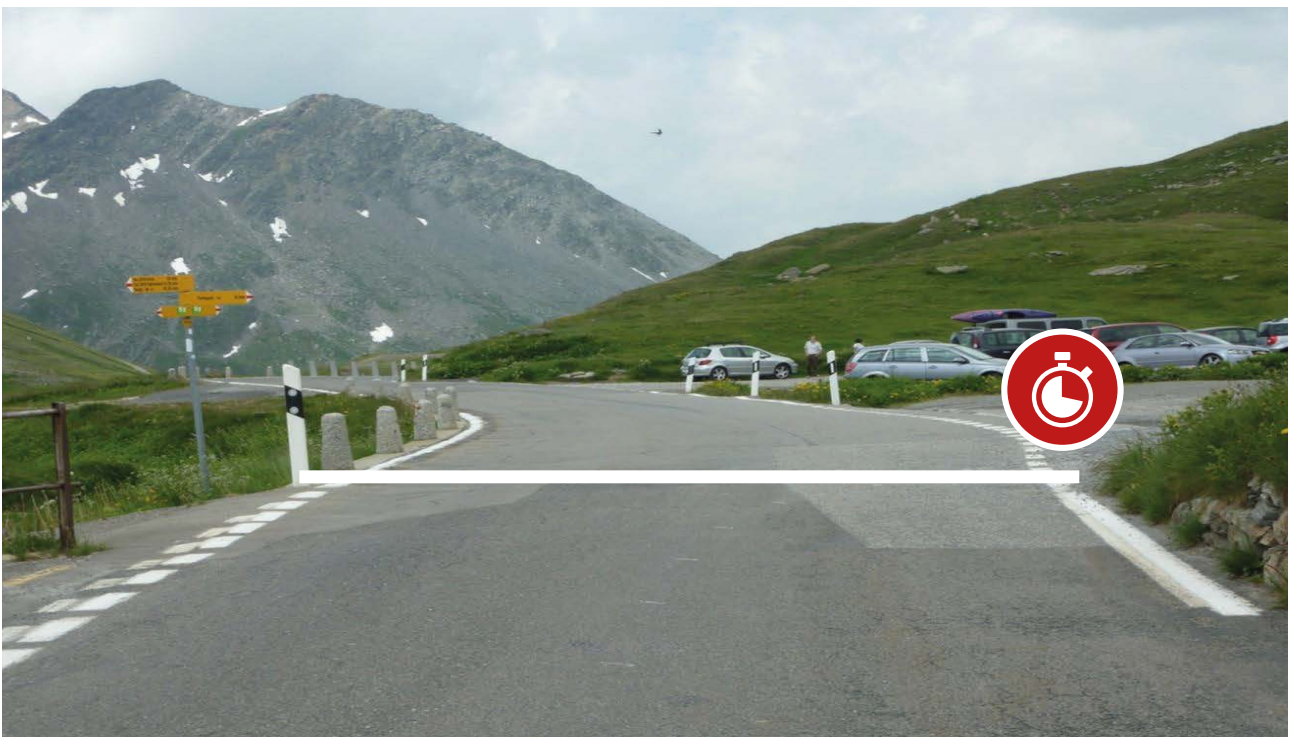

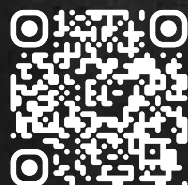

1. Organisation

2. Registration

Please make your registration for the Granfondo San Gottardo 2026 online on our website. If you have any problems with your registration, please contact info@granfondosangottardo.com

Registration deadline and fees:

- 01.10.2025 - 03.10.2025 =
CHF 70.00 online registration
- 04.10.2025 - 09.08.2026 =
CHF 100.00 online registration
- 10.08.2026 - 22.08.2026 =
CHF 140.00 online registration
- 23.08.2026 =
CHF 150.00 on-site registration

If a registered participant cannot attend, the registration fee will not be refunded. In this context, we would like to point out that there is an option to take out cancellation insurance when registering online.

If a registered participant cannot take part, the registration fee will not be refunded. Cancellation insurance for the paid entry fee can be taken out on request at the time of registration. In the event of illness or accident, the insured person will be credited with the paid entry fee on presentation of a medical certificate. Entitlement to reimbursement is only valid if cancellation costs insurance and a medical certificate are available.

If the race cannot be held or can only be held partially due to force majeure, extraordinary risks or official orders, there is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee.

3. Registration fee

The registration fee includes:

- timekeeping
- goodiebag
- bib number
- neutral race service
- emergency service
- feeding zones on the course
- finisher meal in the finish area
- changing room and showers in the finish area
- finisher diploma
- rankings
- free parking
- photo service by Sportograf

4. Payment conditions

5. Late registration

Late registration is possible up to 60 minutes before the start of the race.

6. Distribution of bib number and start package

The bib number distribution will take place on Saturday, August 22, 2026, from 03:00 to 06:00 p.m. and Sunday, August 23, 2026 from 06:30 to 08:30 a.m..

The goodie bag will be handed out at the finish line upon presentation of the voucher.

RULES

7. Race course

The Granfondo San Gottardo provides for two different routes:

Long route:

113 km, 3'217m altitude difference

Ambri – Tremola – St. Gotthardpass – Hospental – Furkapass – Ulrichen – Nufenenpass – Ambri

Short route:

53 km, 1'522m difference in altitude

Ambri – Tremola – St. Gotthardpass – Airolo – Stalvedro – Madrano – Ronco – Quinto – Ambri

The race routes are specially signposted.

The timed routes are:

Long route (marked red):

- Section 1: Airolo – Gotthardpass
- Section 2: Realp – Furkapass
- Section 3: Ulrichen – Nufenenpass

Short route (marked yellow):

- Section 1: Airolo – Gotthardpass
- Section 2: Stalvedro – Ronco

Participants of the long route can switch to the short route after the first section if needed.

8. Start meeting point

Meeting point: on August 23, 2026 from 07:30 a.m. in the starting area in Ambri.

Start big loop group 1: 08:00 a.m. (followed by 3 more starts at 15-minute intervals, you can find your start time and your group in the RaceMail or on [RaceResult](#))

Start small loop: 09:00 a.m.

10. Helmet

Wearing a helmet is compulsory for all categories.

11. Light

Participants are required to have a front light (white) and a rear light (red), and these will be checked during the bike check.

12. Timekeeping

Timekeeping will be carried out by Race-result. The timing is done by means of a chip, which will be handed in at the start number distribution.

Timekeeping will only take place on the climbs to the Gotthard, Furka and Nufenen passes (big loop) or to the Gotthard pass and Ronco (small loop). The rest of the course is neutralised.

The time of the individual sections will be measured individually.

13. Time limits

Long route:

- Arrival on the Gotthardpass by 11:00 a.m. at the latest
- Start timekeeping Furkapass in Realp by 11:30 a.m. at the latest
- Arrival on the Furkapass by 01:00 p.m. at the latest
- Start timekeeping Nufenenpass in Ulrichen by 02:00 p.m. at the latest
- Arrival on the Nufenenpass by 04:00 p.m. at the latest
- Finish in Ambri by 04:45 p.m. at the latest

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RULES

13. Time limits

Short route:

- Arribal on the Gottardpass by 11:30 a.m. at the latest
- Start timekeeping in Stalvedro to Ronco by 12:15 p.m. at the latest
- Arrival in Ronco by 01:00 a.m. at the latest
- Finish in Ambri by 01:30 a.m. at the latest

Important:

Participants, who do not reach the time limits will be withdrawn from the race.

14. Rankings and prizes

The ranking list consists of the sum of the times of the sections. Awards will be given to the first 3 overall winners in the men's and women's categories as well as to the first classified in each category on the long and short course, provided that the race course has been completed in the specified minimum time. No ranking list will be drawn up for category I.

The prizes will only be handed out at the award ceremony, there will be no mailing.

15. General rules for participation

By joining, the participant confirms:

- that he/she has read the regulations and accepts them in their entirety
- that he/she is familiar with the basic principles of the event and that he/she is in a mental and physical condition appropriate for the event
- that he/she will comply with the regulations and the instructions of the race management and the staff in charge.
- that he/she allows his/her personal data to be used by the organisers
- that he/she agrees to the use of pictures, films and recordings of his/her par-

ticipation in the event for all lawful purposes, including advertising purposes

- that he/she waives any claim for liability or damages against the Organiser, its partners or suppliers, staff of any rank, sponsors and promoters arising from his/her participation in the Event or side events.

Furthermore:

- that the organisers accept no liability in the event of non-compliance with these regulations.
- that the organisers may at any time and without appeal decide whether or not to accept an entry; or to exclude an entered competitor from the race if he/she is likely to cause damage to the image of the event
- that all participants shall behave in a fair and sportsmanlike manner during the race and at the start.
- only racing bicycles without electronic support (such as e-bikes) are permitted, exception category e-bike.

16. Road rules, time and place of road closure

The bike race is accompanied by motorcycles. These are uniformly marked.

Road traffic regulations must be observed along the entire route.

A limited driving ban for motorized vehicles is only guaranteed on the following sections:

Airolo – Gotthardpass, from 09:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m..

Stalvedro – Ronco, from 10:30 a.m. to 13:00 p.m..

All other sections are passable as normal but will be controlled by Granfondo staff and the police.

RULES

The descents and remaining sections between the timed sections are neutralized. From the passage of the first motorcycle until the passage of the “Besenwagen”, neither unregistered cyclists nor companions or other third parties may join the race or move in the field of riders. If a rider is assisted by a third party during the race, the participant will be disqualified immediately.

The “Besenwagen” (end of the bike race) will adhere to the maximum passage times.

Any late riders will be allowed to continue on the race course and must abide by the traffic rules. However, there will no longer be a technical and medical service available to them.

17. Insurance

Each participant must have his/her own insurance for non-occupational accidents as well as private liability insurance, for foreigners this must also include a clause for abroad. The organisers disclaim any liability.

18. Feeding

Feeding along the race course is guaranteed exclusively in the zones provided by the organisers. Personal feeding is only allowed in the zones provided by the organisers.

19. Technical support

The organiser provides a neutral technical support service, which can be reached at +41 79 520 60 33 (please contact only on the day of the event). Participants are advised to carry their own spare parts.

Following participants with private vehicles is strictly prohibited. This also applies to cyclists who are not registered for the event. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification.

20. Medical support

Medical care is guaranteed along the course. They can be reached at the following number: +41 79 295 26 99

We recommend that participants download the Echo-SOS app before the event. The app provides the correct emergency numbers worldwide and can transmit GPS-based location data to emergency services. <https://echosos.com/notfall-app/>

21. Doping

Participants sanctioned by the UCI for doping will be refused registration. This is an unappealable decision of the organiser. The use of doping is strictly prohibited.

22. Parking, camping and caravans, tents

The parking areas and tent zone are located at Ambri airfield. Use of the area is free of charge. This is ideal for parking camping and caravans. For a fee of CHF 10.00 per person, you can stay overnight at the campground.

RULES

23. Changing rooms & showers

Opening hours:

Saturday, August 22: 03:00 p.m. – 07:00 p.m.

Sunday, August 23: 06:00 a.m. – 05:30 p.m.

24. Disqualification

Participation with the start number of another participant, the handing over of start numbers to third parties, or other serious circumstances determined by the organisers will lead to disqualification. Failure to observe the traffic rules and regulations and disregarding the security personnel may be reasons for disqualification.

25. Cancellation of the race

The race will be held in all weather conditions, except in the case of special exceptions resulting in danger to participants or in the event of natural disasters. In this case, the organising committee will decide whether part of the participation fees will be refunded or credited to the following year.

26. Environmental protection

All participants shall behave in an environmentally friendly manner. Leaving litter of any kind is forbidden on the entire race track; those who do not comply will be reported to the jury, who will ensure that the participant in question is disqualified.

27. Jury, complaints

The jury will only accept complaints if they are made in the regular manner within 30 minutes after the final results list has been issued and if a deposit of CHF 100.00 (one hundred) is paid beforehand. If the complaint is accepted, the deposit will be refunded.

28. Regulations

The organisers reserve the right to make any changes to the race course and regulations at any time. The changes will be published on the official website.

29. Further information

When collecting the start number, the latest information will be communicated. This information will also be published on the official website.

The official website, www.granfondosan-gottardo.com, provides further information about the routes, the course of the event and about side events that are organised for both participants and accompanying persons.
